- Intensive and regular data analyses as a member of our research team
- Prepare methods and results sections of manuscripts
- Data management
- Provide training and mentorship in quantitative methods to team members
- Acquire a strong understanding of research topics and thorough knowledge of the data and programming efforts involved
- Meet regularly with the research team

A successful candidate will have the following qualifications:

- PhD required, preferably in Psychology, with expertise in quantitative methods
- Expert knowledge of statistical software and modeling programs such as SPSS, Mplus, SAS, and R/R Studio
- Comfort manipulating and analyzing complex, high-volume, high-dimensionality data, with particular emphasis on longitudinal research designs
- Expertise in, or willingness to learn, dyadic data analysis
- A strong passion for empirical research and for answering complex questions using quantitative methods
- High motivation with an ability to solve data analysis problems independently
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Have the ability to communicate clearly and effectively in English, both orally and in writing
